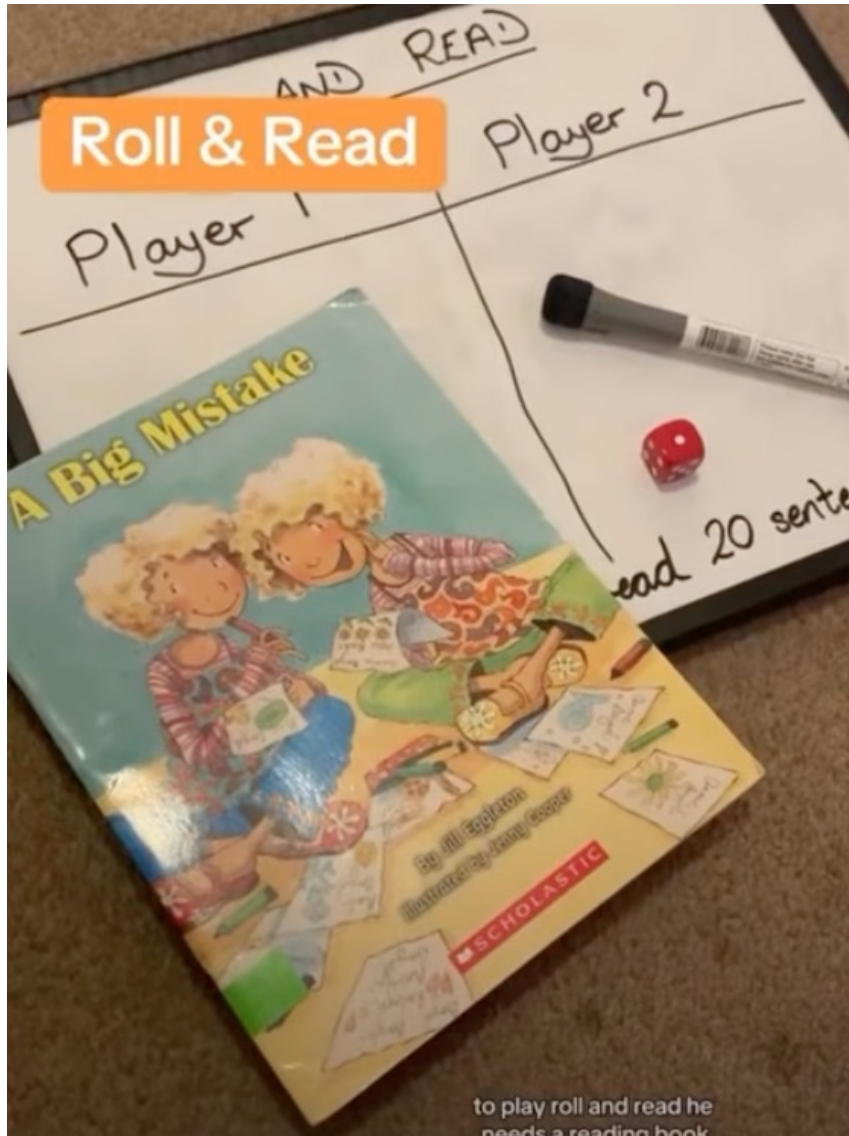
Aim of the Game: Your goal is to read aloud a specified number of sentences determined by the roll of the dice. The first player to read 20 sentences wins the game.

What You Need:

- Reading book
- Pen or pencil for keeping score
- Dice

How to Play:

1. Player one takes the first turn. Roll the dice to determine the number of sentences you need to read.
2. For example, if you roll a six, you must read six sentences from the book.
3. As you read each sentence aloud, mark it down on a tally sheet.
4. The next player then takes their turn, following the same steps.
5. The game continues until one player successfully reads 20 sentences.
6. The first player to reach 20 sentences wins the game!
7. If players want to play again, simply reset the tally and continue rolling and reading.

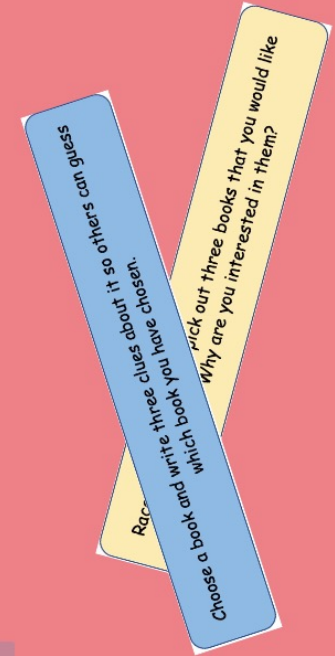
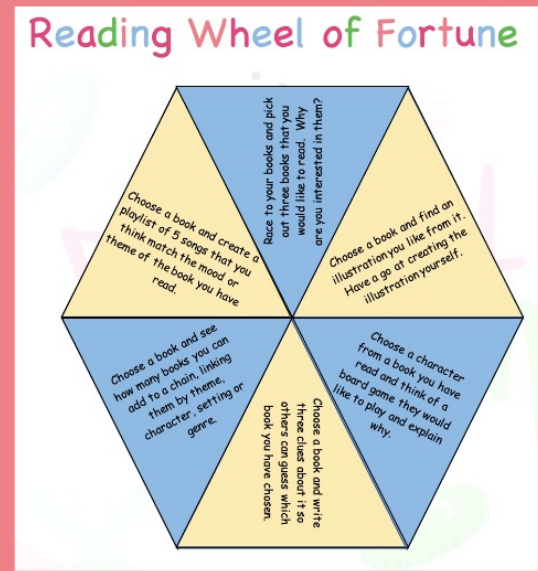


Designed for the sole purpose of making reading a joyous experience, the Reading Wheel of Fortune/Pick Up Sticks is simple and fun to use.
